# FIONA SIMPSON IS LISTENING AND WORKING TO DELIVER MORE LOCALLY.

Everywhere I go local residents tell me how hard it is to make ends meet – or for their family to get ahead. Under Labor, the cost of living and electricity just keeps going up. The LNP's practical plan will help make things easier while investing in local projects like those listed below.

- ✓ A \$250,000 grant to provide public amenities, walking track improvements and better signage at Mount Coolum National Park.
- ✓ Delivering the \$600 million Sunshine Coast Rail Line Duplication between Beerburrum and Landsborough in partnership with the Federal Government.
- ✓ Reducing local congestion and improving access to the Sunshine Coast University Hospital with a \$215 million investment in the Sunshine Motorway-Hospital Link Road.
- ✓ Construction of two new classrooms and removing asbestos as part of a \$3 million upgrade to Maroochydore State High School.
- ✓ Boosting revegetation in the Maroochy River Conservation Park with a \$50,000 Environment Grant.
- ✓ Redeveloping the Mudjimba Surf Life Saving Club House to provide training, meeting rooms and other facilities – \$100,000.
- ✓ A new Sunshine Coast-Moreton Rehabilitation Centre to provide better health services by getting drug addicts off ICE.



## EASING THE COST OF LIVING & CHEAPER ELECTRICITY



The LNP has a plan to tackle the cost of living. It's not fair that wholesale electricity prices have increased by 70% under Labor. The LNP's plan will:

- Freeze family car rego for three years, saving families up to \$200.
- Provide cheaper electricity by increasing competition in the wholesale electricity market and by reducing network charges, saving families an average of \$160 a year.
- Freeze power executive bonuses until electricity prices fall.
- Put Consumer Representatives on the boards of electricity networks – to control costs and lower prices.
- Help seniors with half-price driver licences and free off-peak bus and train travel.
- Provide parents with a \$150 voucher for kids' swimming lessons.



## TOUGH ON CRIME

Crime is out of control under Labor's soft-on-crime approach. The LNP's plan will:

- Deliver 535 more police on the beat across Queensland and treatment services to get drug addicts off ICE – reducing one of the causes of crime.
- Crack down on juvenile crime by: reintroducing 'breach of bail' as an offence; allowing courts to name and shame repeat offenders; and mandatory community service if convicted of car theft or hooning.



## FIXING THE BRUCE HIGHWAY

It's not fair that the Bruce Highway is such a low priority for Labor. The LNP's plan will:

- Commit an extra \$360 million to the 10 year Bruce Highway Action Plan to improve road safety and flood resilience.
- Continue the upgrades between Caloundra Road and the Sunshine Motorway.
- Commence the Bruce Highway upgrade between Caboolture and Caloundra.
