
Working hard for a Stronger Sunshine Coast






Faster travel times for Sunshine Coast residents are why road and rail transport have been prioritised with a \$3.4 billion investment in local upgrades for the Bruce Highway and \$550 million to duplicate the single track Sunshine Coast rail line.

Here's a summary of other funding and services provided over the last three years:












Safer roads with \$21 million for local safety upgrades

Busting Congestion

An LNP State Government will deliver further upgrades to Sunshine Coast roads to make our roads safer and cut travel times as well as investing in better public transport to get more cars off our roads.

Improved Bike & Pedestrian Safety

After strong community backlash, the State Labor Government scrapped its controversial \$8 million Mooloolaba to Maroochydore (M2M) cycleway design through Alexandra Headland. My commitment is to ensure we "get it right" and that the people have a say in the best design which provides safe beach access for all users.

ENHANCED COMMUNITY SAFETY

An LNP Government will keep our children and community safe with sensible laws and more police resources.

Our plan includes:

- Tougher sentences for child killers
- A crack-down on organised crime
- Making repeat violent and child sex offenders wear a GPS tracker
- Introducing a public sex offender register

No New Taxes

PROTECT PUBLIC SPACE AT MOOLOOLABA SPIT

We must protect the Mooloolaba Spit from overdevelopment. The State Labor Government secretly paid consultants \$62,000 to investigate increasing height limits and giving away land to commercial development at the end of the Spit. This will compromise our precious public open space
